Ashland Tidings 5 Feb 1892 C C Beekman who with his family has been spending much of the past year in the East, is expected to return shortly.

Ashland Tidings 12 Feb 1892 C C Beekman and family will return from a six months visit to Dundee, NY on Thurs.

Ashland Tidings 19 Feb 1892 M/M C C Beekman returned last Sat. from a six months visit at Dundee, NY. Their dau. Miss Carrie, who accompanied them East, stopped at Eugene, for a short visit with relatives there.

Ashland Tidings [Aug 1909] The Pioneer Society of Southern OR was organized at Jacksonville, in November of 1876, pursuant to a call printed in the TIDINGS by Editor James Sutton, and signed by a hundred citizens of the county eligible to membership in the proposed organization. The first reunion was held at Ashland in Sept. 1877, in what is now Chautauqua Park. The following is a list of those who signed the call for the organization of the society, the majority of whom have since crossed the Great Divide,....C.C. Beekman
